

**Secretary's Report** – Motion made, seconded and carried to accept June club minutes as posted in this month's SinePost. **Treasure's Report** – Beginning balance: \$9530.41; Field Day expenses: \$87.26; adjusted balance: \$9,443.15. Motion to accept the report as posted was seconded, and carried.

K1AGL presiding. Quorum established to conduct business.

#### Old Business:

- Field Day synopsis provided by KB1JDX. More poles and/or tall trees for antenna mounting will be needed next year to prevent interference from colocated transmitters. Two kids were logged as attendees. Good DX was reported on 10 & 20M. Wolf Den was mentioned as a possible location for FD next year. Logging was discussed. FD material forwarded to W1RB for inclusion in Bulletin blog Ctc: KA1MPG, Jon
- "Easy-Up" purchase KB1JDX reported that a brand name tent will cost almost \$300, more than earlier \$200 estimate and approval. Discussion concerning use of brand vs. off-brand. Motion made to amend previous NTE amount from \$200 to \$300. Seconded and carried. Ctc: KB1JDX
- KB1JDX digital station open house was well attended by both members and non-members. Literature on products used was provided. Ctc: KB1JDX
- Club website still in process of development by K1JSH. Club members invited to view progress and provide comments, suggestions, etc. K1NLX to work with KB1DNO to open a PayPal account for use on the website. Ctcs: committee (WB1CCL, Lynn; KB1JDX, Vinny; K1JSH, Jamie).



- Thompson Day update: letter of request to be submitted to sponsors along with change of location. Antenna issues were discussed. Ctc: KB1JDX, Vinny
- Brooklyn Fair update: letter from fair board member advised ECARA to plan on being there and in the same location as last year. Antenna and PA interference issues were discussed. Ctc: KB1JDX, Vinny

#### New Business:

- Per approval at previous meeting K1AGL ordered recognition pins for distribution at field day. Motion made to reimburse the \$106.35 cost of pins. Seconded and carried.
- K1NLX requested approval to make selected SinePost USPS mailing as deemed necessary to meet special requests for such. Discussion ensued. It was felt that the SinePost editor should be givien limited discretion. Motion made to allow USPS mailings to a maximum of 10 paid members at the sole discretion of the SP editor. Seconded and carried.
- Reminder that the CQ World Wide VHF contest (6&2M) is this coming weekend. Ctc: KE1LI
- Reminder that the ARRL National Centennial Convention in Hartford is also this coming weekend. Ctc: K1ZE
- BSA's JOTA preparedness exercise for 18 Oct in Union, CT was discussed. VHF setup for 8 stations is needed. Ops and stations are needed for this event. More info at next meeting. Ctc: KB1JDX
- Facebook promotion of club was discussed. It was suggested that a one year SinePost subscription be offered to non-affiliates as an enticement to join the club. Also, having a mechanism such as PayPal available for membership fees and potential donations by non-affiliates to the club. Considerable

discussion followed concerning holding a club Facebook promotion for membership. Pros & cons were voiced as to the nature of the giveaways. The concept of a promotion was considered a positive endeavor but the details and rules needed to be further defined. It was agreed that a trial promo be advanced to understand both the mechanism and the consequences, both intended and unintended. A motion was made to allow KB1JDX to have a Club Facebook promotion in September to give away two 1 year 2015 club memberships at his discretion. Motion seconded and carried.

Good of the order:

K1CSP clarified that the new Yeasu P-25 digital repeater is backward compatible for analog signals (contrary to previously disseminated info).

Meeting adjourned at 2018hrs.

- Still discussing benefit of having Commercial Electrical power available. (TBA)


The way I see it, the JOTA GOTA Activity is the Bottle Neck of the entire weekend operation.
