

Secretary's Report:

Motion made to accept December minutes as published in the January SinePost, seconded and carried.

Treasure's Report:

Beginning Balance: \$8581.73; Deposits – shirt order \$75.00; Expenses – shirt vendor \$47, newsletter postage \$10.08, Brooklyn Fair reimbursements, Xmas party tip \$50.87; Ending Balance: \$8508.78. Motion made to accept December's Treasurer's Report was seconded and carried. An Annual Report for 2014 was presented; motion made to accept, seconded & carried.

Old Business:

Propnet Project Presentation

At the February meeting I will be presenting on the Propnet Project (www.propnet.org) and how it can be used to see propagation quality in real time. Propnet uses PSK31 (a digital mode) with an internet backbone to collect and report on stations heard on HF and VHF. From there, results can be plotted on a map, such as this map, which shows 10 meter activity as recorded for 24 hours at my home QTH. The output is exportable in other formats as well. While digital modes might not been everyone's cup of tea, I think that everyone can benefit from

the real time maps provided by Propnet stations. Personally, I use them to spot band openings without having to be in the shack monitoring the radio.
