

Field Day...A Look Back By KA1MPG



I'm having a little trouble accepting that this year will mark my 30th field day. I was only 14, had only been licensed a couple of months, and had never operated before when I attended my first. During the licensing class and club meetings field day was discussed, but that did little to prepare me for what I encountered. Upon arrival at the field day site, which was located on North Road in Killingly, I was amazed at the amount of preparation

and setup that went into field day. It amazed me that all of this work was done to

simulate conditions experienced after a major disaster. Five stations were set up complete with radios, antennas, and tents. All stations were powered by a huge World War II surplus generator that had a Jeep engine.

Back in 1985 novice class operators could only use Morse code and I had only just passed the Morse code test by the skin of my teeth. Thanks to a lot of great coaching by Ron K1VSC I was able to make 20 contacts. I operated the entire 24 hours and had a fantastic time. During the weekend I sat and watched the voice and veteran CW contesters operate. I learned a lot and made many friends.

By the next field day I had upgraded to General Class which allowed me to finally operate HF voice. During that field day a veteran member of the club took me under his wing and really became a mentor to me. That operator was Dick KB1H who passed away just a few weeks ago. What has stood out most strongly during all of my field with the Eastern days Connecticut Amateur Radio





QSO Party By W1UJ

By the time you read this here the <u>New England QSO Party</u> will have just completed (May 2-3). This annual on-the-air HF event takes place each May and livens up nearly every county in New England. Some of you may recall the HAMCOW, where KE1LI and others would venture to Martha's Vinyard to provide the DUKES County multiplier for this event.
