
ECARA Monthly Meeting 8/10/15 at Mashamoquet Brook State Park, Pomfret.

Secretary's Report:

Motion made to accept July minutes as published in the August SinePost as amended: reference to Dick Pechie should have been to Chuck Weimer, Jr., and references to WA1AOG & WB1AOG should have been WB1AOC for both; seconded and carried.

Treasure's Report:

Beginning Balance: \$7379.60; Deposits – dues \$20.00, raffle donation \$28.00; Expenses – FD porta-potty \$126.56, liability insurance \$320, donation in memory of SK Chuck Weimer, Jr; Ending Balance: \$6931.04. Motion made to accept the July Treasurer's Report; seconded and carried.

Old Business:

- It was advised that the insurance rider required under the MOU between the State Police (SP) and ECARA for use of SP tower(s) was sent to and accepted by the SP.
- The channel elements for the backup K1MUJ repeater were not ordered by K1ZE due to the increase in cost (which was more than the amount authorized). A motion was made at the June meeting to table any further action until a subsequent meeting where K1ZE could provide additional clarification and perspective. While he was not at this meeting, K1CSP spoke on his behalf and advised that the club should go ahead with the project as this would provide an operational backup to the K1MUJ VHF repeater, and that the re-crystalling cost increase was minor. Motion made to move forward with the project at the modified authorization of \$225 for the set of crystals; seconded and carried. Ctc: K1ZE
- KB1JDX advised that the club has been registered for Thompson Day on 27 Sep. Location of the trailer, use of generator and demo of solar power discussed.
- KB1JDX also advised that he still needs volunteers for the Brooklyn Fair exhibit. An on-line sign-up sheet is now available. Ctc; KB1JDX
- K1CSP provided background information on the upcoming BSA Jamboree on the Air. The primary goal of this event is to promote the hobby with youth in the area. A few volunteers are needed to provide and set up their go kits for this event. Ctc; K1CSP

New Business:

- KE1LI gave brief on the new event, Harvester 5K XC Road Race. K1CSP volunteered as net control, KB1JDX volunteered as field operator; 4 more ops needed. Start time Sep 26, 9AM.
- K1AGL emphasized that ECARA needs to encourage other members to volunteer for the public service events.
- K1NLX acquired a dedicated printer/scanner for use as secretary and at events such as the picnic, field day, fleamarket, etc. He was also able to acquire brand name ink at 60% savings over cost at Staples, and presented a receipt of \$24.08 for reimbursement of the ink cost. Motion made to reimburse, seconded and accepted.
- K1AGL recommended bringing unclaimed badges to both Brooklyn Fair and Thompson Day before mailing them to recipients in an effort to reduce mailing costs.
- KB1ZOV, again, raffled two beautifully custom-made, hand-held charging stands prior to the business meeting tonight. The proceeds from the raffle have already been donated to the club. Ctc: KB1ZOV
