
ECARA Monthly Meeting 9/14/15 at DKH, Putnam.

Secretary's Report:

Motion made to accept August minutes as published in the September SinePost; seconded and carried.

Treasure's Report:

Beginning Balance: \$6931.04; Deposits – dues \$19.12, raffle donation \$42.00; Expenses – Thompson Day banner \$25, gift basket for member \$42.99, picnic pizza \$87.58, secretary printer ink \$24.08, ECARA PO box renewal \$50; Ending Balance: \$6762.51. Motion made to accept the August Treasurer's Report; seconded and carried.

Old Business:

KB1JQA provided a briefing on the ECARA exhibit at the Brooklyn Fair and mentioned that the telescoping antenna worked fairly well. The use of solar panels was new this year.

- K1CSP provided an update on the upcoming BSA/GSA Jamboree on the Air. Ed & John visited the camp area to determine the logistics in setting up the go-kits. It was determined that two dipoles and one vertical should be sufficient. The area event is expecting about 100 scouts. Volunteers are still needed to provide and set up their gokits for this event Oct 16-18. It was suggested that the club provide QSL cards for the event, discussion ensued. Motion made to purchase QSL cards for the event, and having at minimum: W1S event callsign; ECARA, BSA & GSA logos. Cost NTE \$100 w/o further authorization (qty TBD based on price); seconded & carried. It was also suggested that the club set up the video used at the Brooklyn Fair exhibit.
