## Minutes from ECARA Monthly Meeting 1/8/18 at Day Kimball Hospital, Putnam


Meeting was called to order at 7:09 pm

### VHF Contest

Hi All

In January, I participated in the VHF weak signal contest. This is a contest that I typically do fairly well in. Especially if the Patriots are NOT in the playoffs.

The contest starts on Saturday and runs through Sunday night, and frequencies are from 50MHZ and up. We usually run a multi-op station. As usual, KB1ORX and myself manned much of the contest with help from Ray, W1YFF on Sunday.

The bands were tough but we did have a couple of highlights. A 2M contact to FN25, near Montreal, and a band opening to Newfoundland (that I missed because of the game) are the type of contacts that keep me coming back for more abuse.

K1BAB, Brad, and his harmonic, played Rover with me on FM giving me 44 points, but at the end of the contest, that added over 3000 points to the total score with other multipliers.

It just shows you that FM is a real way to contest. I know there are many out there that have HTs that I could work. If anyone ever want to test to see if they can work me, inside or outside a contest setting, just give me a call. You'll be surprised how far that 2w 440ht will get you.

In the end, we did +23,000 points, 7,000 better than last year, talked and laughed with friends, and blew up a 6M pre amp. \$25 to fix it. No biggie.

Let me know if I can help you with this aspect of the hobby. The more, the merrier.


