KZ1M ECARA Club Station

Jim Dalterio KZ1M was a member of ECARA and of the Yankee Clipper Contest Club (YCCC). Jim was an experienced contestant and a big promoter of Field Day. At most club meetings, he would announce the number of days until the next FD. Jim hosted and operated Single op and multi-op activities at his home.

It was fitting that the club decided to use his call sign for a memorial station. Jon Fournier KA1MPG became the trustee, I volunteered to be the QSL manager, and maintain the Logbook Of The World (LOTW) account.

The first QSOs uploaded to LOTW were on 10-28-2006. Jay Corriveau W1UJ used the call sign in the CQWW DX SSB contest. Since then, KZ1M has been used by W1UJ, K1ZE, most Field Day operations, and me, W1EQ. As of today, 29,967 QSOs have been uploaded, and the QSL response is 12,971. Those QSOs cover many different contests.

Next year will be 20 years since using the KZ1M call sign. I will continue to be the QSL manager and maintain the LOTW account. Last month I renewed the TQSL certificate. It might be time for someone in the club to have access to the password, just in case. I will be 87 next January. I like doing this in Jim's honor. It has been a pleasure.

At the moment, KZ1M is 20 countries short of 100 on 80 and 16 short on 10 for 5BDXCC. Five band DXCC. Nice Certificate. I got one. I hope to use the call sign again in future DX contests to get those numbers up.

Recent activity:

W1UJ and I have used Jim's call sign in numerous contests since the club took over the call after he passed away in 2004.
